Introduction

A warm welcome to **Somerset Ryū Karate!** For more than thirteen years, the club has strived to deliver high quality, authentic, Japanese Shotokan Karate classes to people of all ages and abilities in West Somerset. Karate is an incredibly rewarding activity, with heavy emphasis on positive mental health and wellbeing, discipline, self defence and all-round fitness. There is huge potential for personal growth and achievement as our students work through their grades.

There are multiple training times offered throughout the week from our full-time and fully equipped dōjō in Tonedale; in addition, regular courses and gradings are held throughout the year with some of the finest instructors from England and Japan. This document will outline everything you need to know before joining the club, and highlight some of the features and opportunities available to members.

Membership Options

There are three membership options available, paid on a monthly basis by Standing Order:

Entry Tier: £32

- Four lessons per month

Standard Tier: £42

- Eight lessons per month; recommended for progress
- Unlocks access to specialised coaching class

Premium Tier: £51

- *Unlimited* training throughout the month
- Trade discounts on uniforms and equipment
- 1/3 reduced rate when booking private lessons

Affiliations & Licensing

Our club is affiliated to JKS England, and the Worldwide Headquarters of the renowned Japan Karate Shoto Federation in Tokyo. This also provides membership with the English Karate National Governing Body (EKNGB), and the World Karate Federation (WKF).

New students must apply for an association licence within their first full month of training by visiting www.jksengland.com/members and following the instructional video. This is priced at **£26.00** for the first year, reducing to **£20.00** per annum thereafter; essential member to member insurance cover is included.

Location

All of our classes are held at a uniquely atmospheric full-time dōjō, situated inside the historic Tonedale Mill in Wellington. Built in the late 18th Century, the building was once the largest textile mill in South West England, now Grade II* listed to protect its heritage. We are situated on the first floor of the Bell Tower, next to Brazier Coffee Roasters, with ample car parking on site.

Little Dragons

Our Little Dragons classes for 4-7 year olds provide our youngest members with a gentle introduction to the world of karate. The focus is on fun, all while covering some basic elements of regular training. There are incentives to promote good behaviour and listening skills, including the opportunity for the most improved student each week to take home the Little Dragons mascot, Sensei Bear 熊先生.

Little Dragons move up to our main classes once they reach 8 years old, although varying factors are taken into account for each individual - e.g. confidence in larger groups, behaviour etc.

Tournament Karate

Our classes regularly focus on the development of competitive *kumite* (sparring) and *kata* (forms). Somerset Ryū Karate students have the opportunity to take part in regional and national level competition once they have reached the appropriate standard; there's even a pathway for our most talented competitors to represent JKS England at UK and International events by earning selection on to the association squad each year.

Grading Examinations

JKS England *kyu* gradings are held at our dōjō three to four times per year at regular intervals. On most occasions, a senior JKS instructor is invited to teach a special class and conduct the examination. Little Dragons (ages 4-7) have their own tailored syllabus, and grade with the club instructor on a separate date. Prices are as follows:

JKS Grading (8yrs+): £35.00

Little Dragons Examination (4-7yrs): £20.00

The above cost includes a new belt. Students will be entered for the examination once they have reached the required standard through regular training. Assessments are carried out prior to each JKS grading, ensuring that all potential candidates are ready to make progress.

Private Lessons

Private one-to-one tuition is available on request; this provides an opportunity for accelerated learning to advance any aspect of your karate, or help prepare for a grading examination. Prices start from **£30.00** per hour, with discounts available for Premium Tier members.
